# **TASC Collection Overview**

The W's

#### Who submits TASC Data?

- Student School Identifier- the building which has the subject tied to it
- Private schools Accredited
  - For all students for which they are the Student School Identifier

#### Who to submit?

- Pre-k through 10<sup>th</sup> Grade
- Public school students
- Accredited private school's students
- 4-year-old At-risk program participants



What is the purpose for submitting TASC data?

 Focuses on providing links among the courses students take during the school year and the educator teaching the course.



When is TASC Data submitted?

- August 1, 2017 June 1, 2018
- Cannot be mixed in KIDS batches



#### Why is TASC Data Collected?

- TASC Records are being collected in order to provide an educator, course, and student link. Uses of this data may include:
  - Provide educators a link to current students' data in Center for Educational Testing and Evaluation (CETE) accounts for ELA and Math interim assessments;
  - Create list of Pre-K students to report survey data in Success in School

- R Required = Must contain a valid non-blank value.
- X Required = Must contain valid non-blank value or must be blank: blanks will be considered a null value
- O Optional = Must contain a valid non=blank value or must be blank: blanks will be considered no response. Field will be validated and stored if submitted.





#### Unique and Valid Records

- Unique fields –values making a record individually identifiable; last record submitted updates system (TASC records are unique by set)
- Valid fields values making a record true

- Match unique fields + "99"

#### Kansas Interactive Testing Engine® (KITE)™

- TASC creates rosters in the Educator Portal in KITE for setting up Interim assessments
  - Interim rosters are unique by building per State Subject Area Code
  - DLM Interim assessments are not available
- When TASC records sent
  - Student School Id establishes the building
  - The State Subject Area Code determines the Interim subject
  - Only one subject area/student combination per building
  - The roster is assigned to the teacher on the last submitted TASC record
- TASC records are NOT for State Assessment test tickets or cPass

#### **Success in School**

Collects school readiness data for 4-year-old At-Risk and 4-year-old Pre K

- TASC Records create a roster of students available for selection in Success in School for an educator
  - TASC Records required for 4-year-old At-Risk and 4-year-old Pre K students







  - ELA and Math Interim Assessments
  - Pre-k students for survey data in Success in School
- Utilize Reports and Resources
- Participate in KIDS conference calls
