What is new with the SMSC Collected?

- Respective dates
- CCD Locale Codes

The W's

Why is SMSC Collected?

- For small districts eligible for Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP) funding

When is SMSC Collected?

- December 1, 2017 – January 5, 2018
- As of December 1/ last day of school

The W's

What is SMSC Data used for?

- Funding calculations based on demographic and attendance data from eligible districts, including eligibility for:
 - The Small Rural School Achievement (SRSA) grant
 - The Rural Low-Income grant

The W's

Who submits the SMSC Data?

- Districts with a Common Core of Data (CCD) locale code of 32, 33, 41, 42, or 43 eligible for additional REAP
 - Funding School for all public school districts
 - Private schools (accredited or non-accredited) do not qualify

The W's

Who to submit?

- K-12 – full and part time students
- Students from first day of school to December 1



SMSC Submission and Data

SMSC Submission and Data

- Building Codes: Submit a valid school ID or district central office if '0001' or '0002' is entered as the Accountability School
- School Entry Date: Based on the student's Funding School entry

SMSC Submission and Data

- REAP Funding:
 - Based on the Average Daily Attendance (ADA)
 - Districts only are eligible
- Students Leaving before December 1: Submit all students enrolled and/or exited from the first day of school to December 1



SMSC Submission and Data

- Days in Membership and Days in Attendance Fields:

- RE/ENROLLMENT depends on field values
- Days in Attendance field values are collected through December 31, 2017
- Reflect time student attends, exits, and then re-enrolls

SMSC Attendance Rate - Detail

This report calculates the Attendance Rate for each student by Funding School. (Student Attendance Rate = days in attendance + days in membership.) The Attendance Rate calculation represents attendance from the beginning of the school year through December 1st for students in grades K-12. School-level users will be able to see all students submitted with their school listed as the funding school.

This report calculates the funding district's Average Daily Attendance (ADA) by summing the School ADA calculations for each school in the district. Each School's ADA is calculated by locating the maximum value for D21 (Cumulative Number of Days in Membership) for each school and dividing the total attendance days for all students in each school by this number. The District ADA calculation represents attendance from the beginning of the school year through December 1st of the school year.

SMSC Best Practices

SMSC Best Practices

Days in Membership and Days in Attendance Fields:

- Carefully review for reasonableness (i.e., 180 days in attendance is not reasonable for August-December data)

Shared Student Example: Private school sped student at public school

A public school (1111) receives funding for special education services for a private school's (2222) student. The public school submits the SMSC. Attendance and membership is based on the time spent at the funding school.

Do not include: Students served at a learning center, via virtual education, or by any other means where state funding is not received and/or attendance data is not provided

SMSC Record for Public School: (1111)

- ☐ Accountability School: 2222
- ☐ Funding School: 1111
- ☐ Attendance School: 1111

SMSC Record for Private School: (2222)

- ☐ No record submitted

Shared Student Example: A student attending two schools at the same time

Two schools (1111 & 2222) receiving funding, both schools would need to report a student for SMSC. Both schools include the appropriate Cumulative Days in Membership and the Cumulative Days in Attendance

SMSC Record for School A: (1111)

- ☐ Accountability School: 1111
- ☐ Funding School: 1111
- ☐ Attendance School: 1111
- ☐ Days in Membership: 72
- ☐ Days in Attendance: 70

SMSC Record for School B: (2222)

- ☐ Accountability School: 2222
- ☐ Funding School: 2222
- ☐ Attendance School: 2222
- ☐ Days in Membership: 72
- ☐ Days in Attendance: 70
