KELPA2

- TEST records should be submitted to the KIDS system by January 12 for students that will take the KELPA2 assessment.

PNP's

- Enter in KITE by January 19 for any of those students that need accommodations.

The W's

Why is TEST Collected?

- Focuses on gathering data for State assessments
- Provides demographic data for accountability subgroups

When is TEST Collected?

- September 5, 2017 – June 29, 2018



The W's

What is TEST Data used for?

- Generates test tickets in the KITE portal at CETE
- Populates AMOSS (Academic Measures of Student Success) and the Public Report Card

What TEST Data is not used for

- Interim assessments
- DLM assessments

The W's

Who submits TEST Data?

- Accountability School – including Accredited Private Schools
- Attendance School

Who to submit?

- Grades K-12 who are eligible to take State assessments

- Proctor: Scorer for History/Government Assessment in KITE
 - One licensed educator per student
 - Educator Portal access to student; administered through CETE
 - Required in order to score the writing section
 - Not necessarily person in room administering assessment
- Related Fields:
 - D79: State History/Gov Assessment
 - D80: State History/Gov Proctor ID
 - D81: State History/Gov Proctor First Name (Optional)
 - D82: State History/Gov Proctor Last Name (Optional)

State Assessment Overview

cPass Overview

- Students can take various assessments
 - General CTE Assessment
 - End of Pathways Assessment s (e.g. Agricultural, Animal, Plant, etc...)
 - Career Competency Qualifier (CCQ)
 - End of Pathways and CCQ with or without module and assessment respectively
- Separated into content area assessments
 - Comprehensive Agriculture
 - Animal Systems
 - Plant Systems, etc.
- If incorrect cPass option sent
 - First “clear” previous cPass
 - Then send updated test type



State Assessment Overview

DLM

- DLM: Dynamic Learning Maps - test assessment given to students with significant cognitive disabilities
- Tests strictly administered through KITE
- Test tickets data is not sent to KIDS
- Students taking the DLM assessment are not submitted on KIDS TEST records

DO NOT SEND TEST RECORDS TO KIDS FOR DLM ASSESSMENTS!!!!!!

Shared Student

A public school is providing math instruction and assessing a student in math. A private school is providing instruction in all other assessed content areas and will be assessing a student in ELA, science, and history/government.

TEST Submission and Data

Shared Student

- Gained/Lost emails – increase when schools (public and private) share a student and both will assess the student in different subject areas
- Accountability School submitting TEST records
 - Schools should only submit records for subject areas they intend to test
 - No need to reclaim student if accurate TEST records are submitted from each school with the appropriate building codes for the Accountability School

 - Different Accountability Schools can submit TEST records for the

TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements

- **Accountability School**
 - When '0001' or '0002' is entered, the Attendance School must be a valid school ID
 - Assessment results are then the Attendance School's accountability determinations
- **Attendance School** – denotes where students will physically take assessments



TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements

- School Entry Date – based on date the student entered the Accountability or Attendance School, depending on the TEST record
- School Entry/EXIT Withdrawal Dates – determines if student is to be included for participation and/or performance in accountability calculations

Demographic Fields - Determines student sub-groups for accountability purposes

- D8: Gender
- D12: Hispanic Ethnicity
- D30: Comprehensive Race

TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements

- Eligibility for National School Lunch Program: Community Eligibility Provision
 - Schools should report students eligible for free or reduced lunch based on Direct Certification and the Kansas Household Economic Survey
 - Non CEP school do not change their reporting
 - CEP schools should NOT report 100% here based on CEP since eligibility only is collected



TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements

Grouping Indicators - How a district would like tickets sorted for distribution to schools

Example:

- Grouping Indicator 1 – primary way by which a district wants test tickets sorted for distribution to schools
 - E.g.: Grouping Indicator 1 = Ms. Smith
- Grouping Indicator 2 – secondary way by which a district wants test tickets sorted within Grouping Indicator 1
 - E.g.: Grouping Indicator 2 = 1st period

TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements

Clear Codes and EXIT Records

Clear Codes

- Student is still in membership
- “C” code removes students from rosters for assessment errors
- Subject specific
- Submit another TEST record with same data including (D2 & D16) with a “C” code in subject to be cleared
- TEST record with a “C” will NOT remove student’s assessment results from calculations if student already started or completed assessment
- KSDE staff will investigate erroneous “C” situations

EXIT Records:

- Student is no longer in membership
- Removes students from a school /district’s state assessment roster, the accountability performance and/or participation calculations
- Removes students from all test subjects (unless student already completed)

“0” does not remove a student from test roster for that subject

TEST Submission and Data

Data Elements - Clear Codes and EXIT Records

Example 1: “Jane Doe” was submitted on a TEST record as taking the ELA, Mathematics, and Science assessments at School A but Jane moved to Nebraska before the testing window opened...

Clear Codes- NO

- Not a “C” in all assessment fields

EXIT Record - YES

- School A then submits an EXIT record for Jane

Example 2: “Jane Doe” moves during the testing window and has completed the ELA assessment but has not completed the mathematics or science assessments...

Clear Codes- NO

- A “C” code submitted in one or more test subject areas does not replace the EXIT records for students who move, dropout, graduate, transfer, etc.

EXIT Record - YES

- EXIT record removes Jane from the School A's roster for math and science, but ELA may be counted for performance and participation

TEST Best Practices

- Check documents and resources for updates
- Do not submit Exit data with the TEST upload
- Student data that is submitted for TEST should be current as of the day the student takes an assessment
- Check TEST related reports for data accuracy
- Participate in KIDS conference calls
