Who Submits & When

- Who - Student's School Identifier
- When - August 3, 2020 – September 7, 2021
 - CTE Courses by June 15, 2021
 - Migrant Summer Services June 1 – September 3, 2021



Students to Submit

- CTE Pathways Courses & Certifications
- Dual Credit
- Migrant / Summer Services
- Virtual Ed/20+
- Work-based learning

CTE & Dual Credit

- CTE Pathways Courses & Certifications
 - Single Parent Student – KCC ID F, C, L, X
- Dual Credit – C, D, L, R
 - Single Parent Student – C, L



Migrant & Migrant Summer

- Migrant – Migrant Coordinator designated
 - Enrollment – '00'
 - EXIT – 30 days
 - Early EXIT – '04' – 2 days
- Summer Services
 - Enrollment – '00'
 - 'MigrantServices'



Grade Level '33'

- 3 years on/before August 31
- Meet at-risk criteria
- No IEP



Letter & Percent Grade

- Letter
 - When '01', '02', or '04' Course Status
 - 2 characters
- Percent
 - 0 – 100 scale
 - 5 characters



Summer School & Virtual

- Summer School
 - July 31 courses - '2021' School Year
 - Respective student populations
- Virtual
 - '1'
 - 20 + course verification



Work-based Learning

- Work-based learning
 - Courses containing work-based learning
 - Pathway Application level courses
 - District's teachers/staff determine
 - Personalized Learning Plan Guidance doc

- KCAN (Student Course)
 - CTE Certificates
 - Current KCAN Records
 - Current Year Credit by Student Report
 - Virtual 20 and Over KCAN Records Report
- Standard
 - Accepted Records (Batch)
 - Accepted Records by Type - KCAN



EXIT Collection Overview



The Latest

- Fields Added:
 - D21: First Instructional Date
 - D29: Unweighted Grade Point Average (GPA)
 - D30: Qualified Admissions



Who Submits

- Accountability School
- Attendance School (if 0001 or 0002 Accountability)



Submission Window

- Anytime KIDS open
- As soon as student leaves



Students to Submit

- Pre-K through adult
- Pre-K students
 - EXIT when student leaves Accountability School
 - Not when student leaves program

Data as of last day of membership



EXIT Details



Dropout/Graduation Summary Report

- 4-year adjusted cohort – annual dropout
 - 4-year adjusted cohort (n) - uses EOYA and EXIT



Dropout/Graduation Summary Report

- 4-year adjusted cohort formula
 - X = four-year regular high school grads (seniors) (EXIT)
 - / divided by
 - Y = original freshman class (+ & - entry and exits) (EOYA)
 - N = 4-year adjusted cohort graduation rate

$$X / Y = N$$



EXIT/Withdrawal Date

- As of last day of membership, graduation
- When Accountability School affiliation ends
- May 2021 vs August 2021



First Instructional Date

- Must complete if one or more of the following
 - Primary Disability = 'WD'
 - Gifted Student = 'GI'
 - Residence of Homeless... > 0
 - Military Connected ... > 0
- Blank if none of these conditions



First Instructional Date

First Instructional Date Criteria by Collection Chart

Unweighted Grade Point Average

- Cumulative Graduating GPA
 - Required for value '8'
 - 0.00 – 4.00
 - 0.00 =F, 1.00=D, 2.00=C, 3.00=B, 4.00=A



Qualified Admissions & Scholars Curriculum

- Kansas Qualified Admissions
 - Appendix F – KBOR Standards – undergraduates
- Scholars Curriculum - Recommended over required for value '8' (File Specs)
 - Values: 0 = No; 1 = Yes


