 - History/Gov Analyze Context and Draw Conclusions Score
 - History/Gov Recognize and Evaluate Score
 - History/Gov Research and Make Connections Score
 - Individual Plan of Study (IPS)



The Latest

- Fields Changed:
 - Gifted Student Indicator (Name change)
 - KPP – Added value and comment clarification
 - KPAT – Added value and comment clarification
 - Military Connected Student Indicator – comment clarification
 - Primary Disability Indicator – (Name change)
 - Special Circumstances Transfer Choice – Value 5 added



When and Who

Window

- May 10, 2021 – June 25, 2021

Students

- GL 05-18 Any time “accountable” students

School

- Accountability or Attendance (0001/0002 Accountability)



Why

- Use of Data
 - Attendance rates and federal funding
 - Accountability subgroup determination
 - Title I data – used in LCP
 - Chronic absenteeism



EOYA Collection Details



AMOSS

- Academic Measures of Student Success
- Participation and Graduation rates, assessment performance
- Correction window when window opens



Attendance and Membership

- Days present and days school open
- Absent – per district
 - Not physically present
 - No instruction participation on/off site
 - Absences (excused) = no days attended



Changes in Status

- May reflect June 30 status
- Or last day of school
- Ex: 504 Qualified
- Appendix A



Chronic Absenteeism

- Days in Attendance / Days in Membership
- Federally mandated aggregated reports
- Students absent 10% or greater



Federal Graduation Cohort Formula

- Grade Level 14 starts cohort
- Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate
 - Freshman +/- transfers in and out to Senior
 - Graduates/Adjusted cohort
- Formula follows over four years



Dyslexia Screener

- Identify dyslexic / struggling readers
- Use Screening Rubric link
- Requirements “reliable” and “valid”



Dyslexia Spring Benchmark Performance Level:

- Performance level from Spring window



Dyslexia Subtest

- Dyslexia identifiers – PSF, NWF, ORF
- Kansas schools screening students
- KSDE values - K PSF (01), 1st NWF (02), 2nd NWF (03)
- Record Spring performance; not composite



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program

- Indication of eligibility based on Direct Certification or NSLP application
- Non CEP school do not change reporting
- CEP schools do NOT report 100%



First Instructional Date

- Qualifying conditions
- Qualifying collections
- (Appendix G File Specifications)

- 3 years on/before August 31
- Meet at-risk criteria
- No IEP



History/Government Assessment

- GL : 08 - 17
- TEST - History/Gov Assessment "2" - Piloted districts
- EOYA – mark three task scores – D78-D80



History/Gov Tasks & Scores

- Tasks

- Recognize and Evaluate
- Analyze Context and Draw Conclusions
- Research and Make Connections

- Scores

- 00 = Not assessed
- 01 - 04 = Performance Level 1 - 4



Immigrant Student

- Age 3 – 21
- Not US born
- Not attending U.S. school for > 3 academic years
- Foreign Exchange Students



Inactive Students

- Submitting does not mean claiming



Individual Plan of Study

- Grade levels 11-17
- Blank for all other grades



Kansas Parents as Teachers Program (KPAT)

- Required for 00-04 grades, not 03
- Specific family program awareness
- Only students part of State-funded PAT programs
- Indicates current school year participation



Kansas Pre-K Pilot Program (KPP)

- Required for 01-04 grades (not 03)
- Participates/ed in KPP during school year



Multiple Accountability Schools

- All schools “claiming” student
- John Smith
 - School A - 8/15/20 – 11/20/20
 - School B – 11/20/20 – 5/17/21



Qualified for 504

- Qualified – even without written plan
- W/D = qualified



Residence of Homeless Students While Homeless

- Nighttime residence
- Lacked fixed, regular, adequate residence
- At any time in school year



School Entry Date

- Date student entered Accountability School



Special Circumstances

- Accountability School '0001' or '0002'
 - Attendance School submit
 - Date taking classes at Attendance School



Title I Participation

- “School Wide” = ‘1’ – Including Pre-K if part of building
- “Targeted Assistance” – only students receiving



Truant Students

- “Yes”/ “No” field
- “Truancy” – state, district, or school policy violation
- State Statute – 72-1113 – authority and guidance



Undoing EOYA

- Cumulative Number of Days in Membership = -1
- Cumulative Number of Days Attended = 0



Virtual Education Students

- Virtual student at any point
- Only school/program or contractor submits

- Attendance Rate Report
- Average Daily Attendance
- Chronic Absenteeism
- Student Attendance Ratio Report



Data Quality

- Current Year EOYA Submission Comparison Report
- EOYA EXIT Assignment Comparison Report
- EOYA Prior Year Subgroup Comparison Report
- Virtual Schools Comparison Report



Standard

- Accepted Records by Type—EOYA
- Current Year Accountability Students
- EOYA Report
- Homeless Student

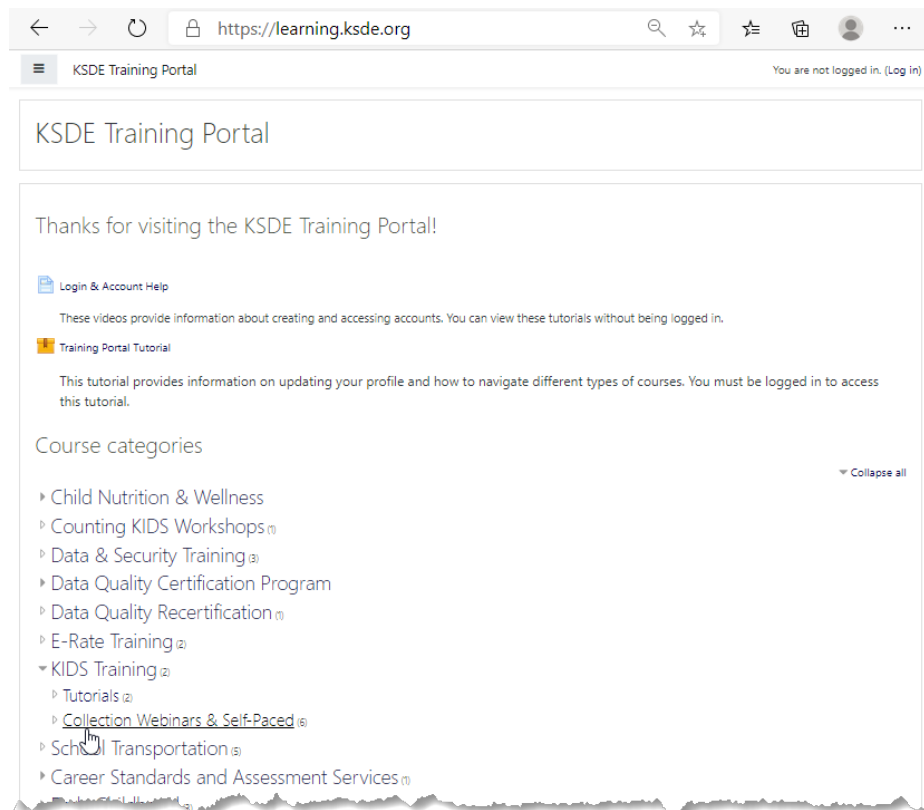

- F25 – F27: History/Gov Assessment Task Score 1 – 3
- KCC ID
“HistoryGovScore”



Who Submits & When

- Who - Student's School Identifier
- When - August 3, 2020 – September 7, 2021
 - CTE Courses by June 15, 2021
 - Migrant Summer Services June 1 – September 3, 2021



Students to Submit

- CTE Pathways Courses & Certifications
- Dual Credit
- Migrant / Summer Services
- Virtual Ed/20+
- Work-based learning



KCAN Details



CTE & Dual Credit

- CTE Pathways Courses & Certifications
 - Single Parent Student – KCC ID F, C, L, X
- Dual Credit – C, D, L, R
 - Single Parent Student – C, L



Migrant & Migrant Summer

- Migrant – Migrant Coordinator/designate
 - Enrollment – '00' – Course Status
 - EXIT – 30 days
 - Early EXIT – '04' – 2 days
- Summer Services
 - Enrollment – '00' – Course Status
 - 'MigrantServices' – F19, F20, F21
 - '80' – 'Received Services...' – Course Status



Grade Level '33'

- 3 years on/before August 31
- Meet at-risk criteria
- No IEP



Letter & Percent Grade

- Letter
 - When '01', '02', or '04' Course Status
 - 2 characters
- Percent
 - 0 – 100 scale
 - 5 characters



Summer School & Virtual

- Summer School
 - July 31 courses - '2021' School Year
 - Respective student populations
- Virtual
 - '1'
 - 20 + course verification



Work-based Learning

- Work-based learning
 - Courses containing work-based learning
 - Pathway Application level courses
 - District's teachers/staff determine
 - Personalized Learning Plan Guidance doc
ksde.org

- KCAN (Student Course)
 - CTE Certificates
 - Current KCAN Records
 - Current Year Credit by Student Report
 - Virtual 20 and Over KCAN Records Report
- Standard
 - Accepted Records (Batch)

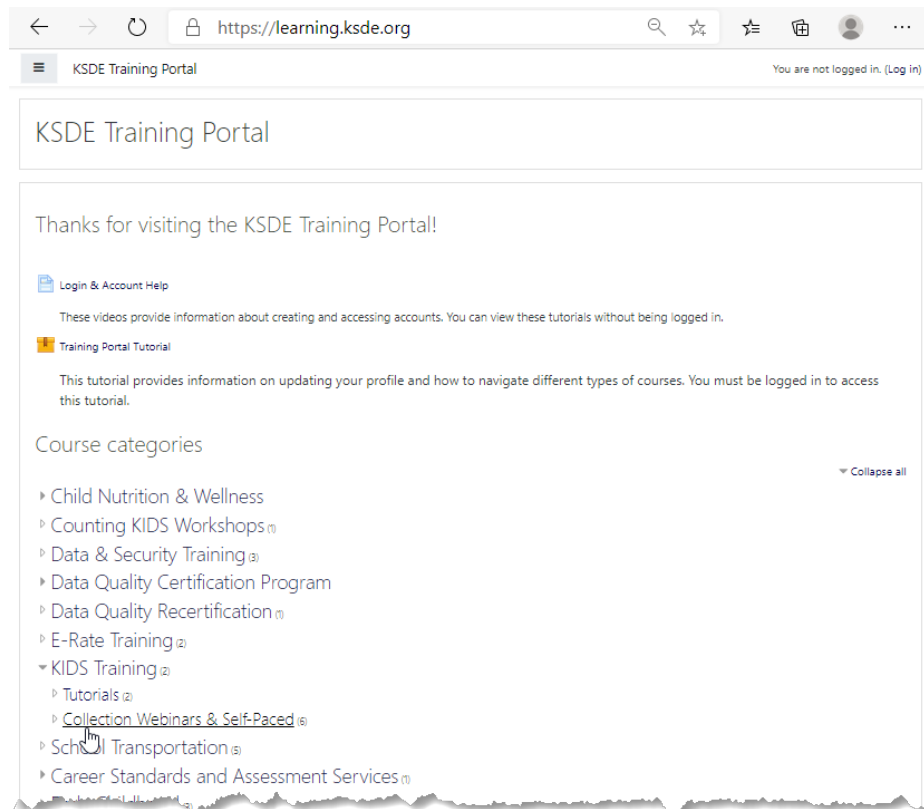
