

 - •Audit exceptions for 22-23 virtual student upload error
 - •funded up to 6 credits

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Virtual - 19 and under DDCVS

- Criteria
 - Enrolled and attending virtually
 - •19 or younger (as of September 20)
 - •Grades 09 12 and UG

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Virtual - 19 and under DDCVS

- Credit ratio less than 75% (Cohort year)
 AND HS dropout by
 - No current year attendance for 60 consecutive days or more OR
 - No previous year attendance for 60 consecutive days or more and not reasonably anticipated enroll or attend current year

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Virtual – 19 and under DDCVS?

- •Credit ration less than 75% (Cohort year) AND HS dropout by
 - OR exempted from compulsory student attendance (parental written consent);
 - Not counted in full or part time enrollment of a virtual during the school year.

 - IEP student exception no expulsion

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Students to Submit

- Pre-K through adult
- Pre-K students
 - EXIT when student leaves Accountability School
 - Not when student leaves program
- *Data as of last day of membership*

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Correcting an EXIT

- •Incorrect Information
 - Resubmit: SSID, Acct Scl, Ex W/D Date, and correct info
- Incorrect Exit W/D Date
 - "99" and resubmit

Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Change reminder:and/or At-Risk Funding
- Free / Reduced-price lunch indication via
 - Direct Cert
 - NSLP application

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Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Approved CEP Schools
 - Not 100%
 - Only eligible via Household Economic Survey
- Non-CEP Schools no change

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EXIT and Assessments

- EXITs remove in Kite
- Undo '99'
- Overall removal not same as 'C' value

EXIT/Withdrawal Date

- Last day of membership, graduation, met graduation requirement
- When Accountability School affiliation ends
- •School Year May vs August

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Impact - Untimely EXITs

- As soon as possible
- Extended absence school's, district's discretion
- •TEST assessed/not assessed
- Graduation non-graduates, unresolved May August

- School Entry Date
 - Accountability School
 - •0001 or 0002 Attendance School
- Special Circumstances for Accountability School Submitting EXIT Records - 0001 or 0002 – Attendance School

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Students With Disabilities

- •Scenario One Met Graduation
 - ■Use '22'
 - Did not receive diploma
 - •W/D Primary Disability
 - Continue receive transitional services
 - Grade 12
 - '8' No longer receiving services

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Students With Disabilities

- •Scenario Two Suspended, Expelled
 - Still active, do not EXIT
 - District obligated
 - Legal requirements SPED & Gen Ed
 - Administrators and counsel involved

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Unweighted Grade Point Average

- Cumulative Graduating GPA
 - Required for value '8'
 - **0.00** 4.00
 - 0.00 =F, 1.00=D, 2.00=C, 3.00=B, 4.00=A
