

KIDS Collection 2022-2023 Planned Changes

Introduction

This document outlines the updates and changes to be made to the KIDS Collection System for 2022-2023 SY. There are no added fields that resulted in renumbering of the data fields. There were 2 fields that have been removed and the columns after have been renumbered.

Modifications to KIDS for 2022-2023 SY are made because of changes in requirements due to the passing of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), bills passed by the Kansas legislature, and to fulfill the vision of the Kansas State Board of Education.


