



KIDS Collection 2020-2021 Planned Changes

Introduction

This document outlines the updates and changes to be made to the KIDS Collection System for 2020-2021 SY. Fields are being added and removed resulting in renumbering of many of the data fields.

Modifications to KIDS for 2020-2021 SY are made because of changes in requirements due to the passing of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), bills passed by the Kansas legislature, and to fulfill the vision of the Kansas State Board of Education.

General Overview

The KIDS 2020-2021 File Specifications document has updated values and fields to reflect changes for the upcoming school year.

Add this notice to the File Specs

ATTENTION: Accountability schools must report *All Students* who attend school, at any time during the school year, and for any amount of time. All students NEED to be submitted in a KIDS record.

Funding schools must report *All Students* who apply, during reporting windows for ENRL, SMSC, and MILT, and for any amount of time. All students NEED to be submitted in a KIDS record
