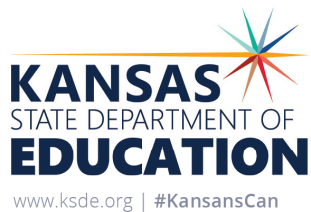

# SMSC Collection Overview

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# What's New?

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**No changes with respect to the SMSC**

# When and Who

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## **Window**

- December 1, 2022 – January 6, 2023

## **Students**

- Full and Part-time through December 1

## **Districts**

- Locale codes 32-33, 41-43 (REAP Eligible)

# Why



## Use of Data

- Funding based on demographics and attendance
- Small Rural School Achievement (SRSA) grant
- Rural Low-Income grant

# SMSC Collection Details



# Days in Membership/Attendance

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- REAP funding depends on
- Attend, exit, reenroll...



# Funding School

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- Similar to ENRL: Funding School Reports
- ALSO Submit if Accountability School is '0001' or '0002'
- School Entry Date – entered Funding School

# REAP Funding

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- Based on Average Daily Attendance (ADA)
- Includes Rural Low-Income School and Small Rural Schools grants
- Districts with CCD locale code (32 - 33, 41- 43) eligible
- Districts only

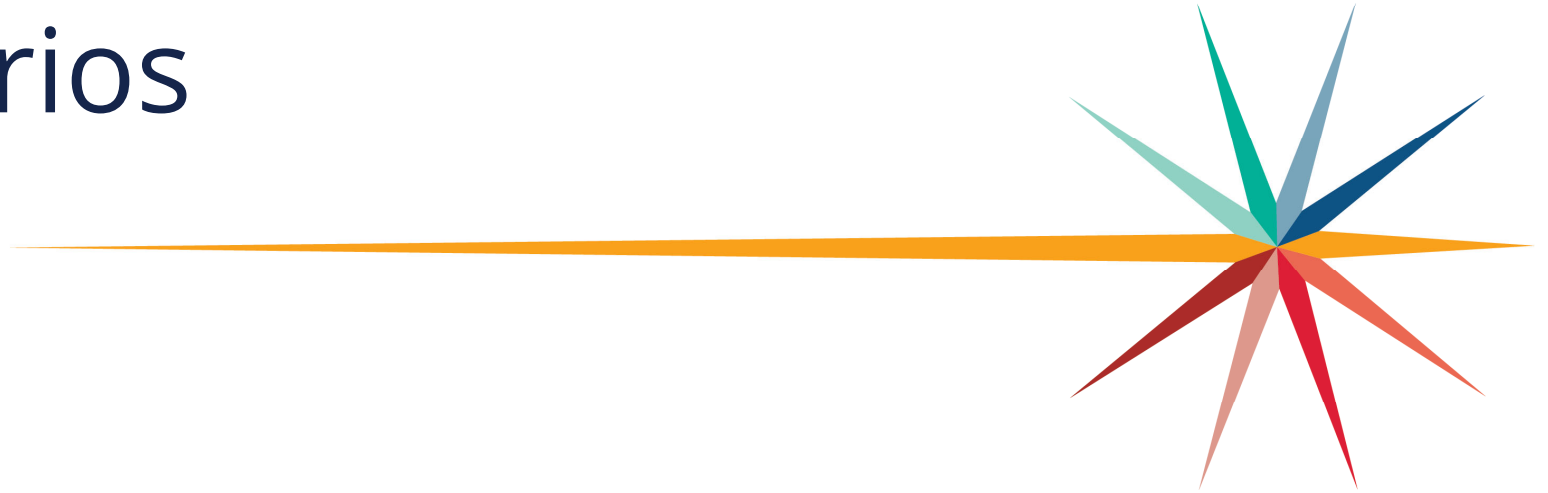
# Students Leaving before December 1

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- Submit all students August - December 1, 2022
- Cumulative Days in Membership/ Attended in submitting school only

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## **Public School**

- Accountability School
- Funding School
- Attendance School

## **Private School**

- Do not submit

# SMSC Scenario – Student Moves



## **Public School A**

**08/11/2022 –**

**11/04/22**

- Accountability School
- Funding School
- Attendance School
- Days In Membership: 61
- Days Attended: 60

## **Public School B**

**11/07/2022 –**

**12/01/22**

- Accountability School
- Funding School
- Attendance School
- Days In Membership: 15
- Days Attended: 14

# Best Practices - SMSC



- Days in Membership / Attendance reasonableness (i.e. 180 days ?)
- Not for Private schools
- Submit data as of December 1

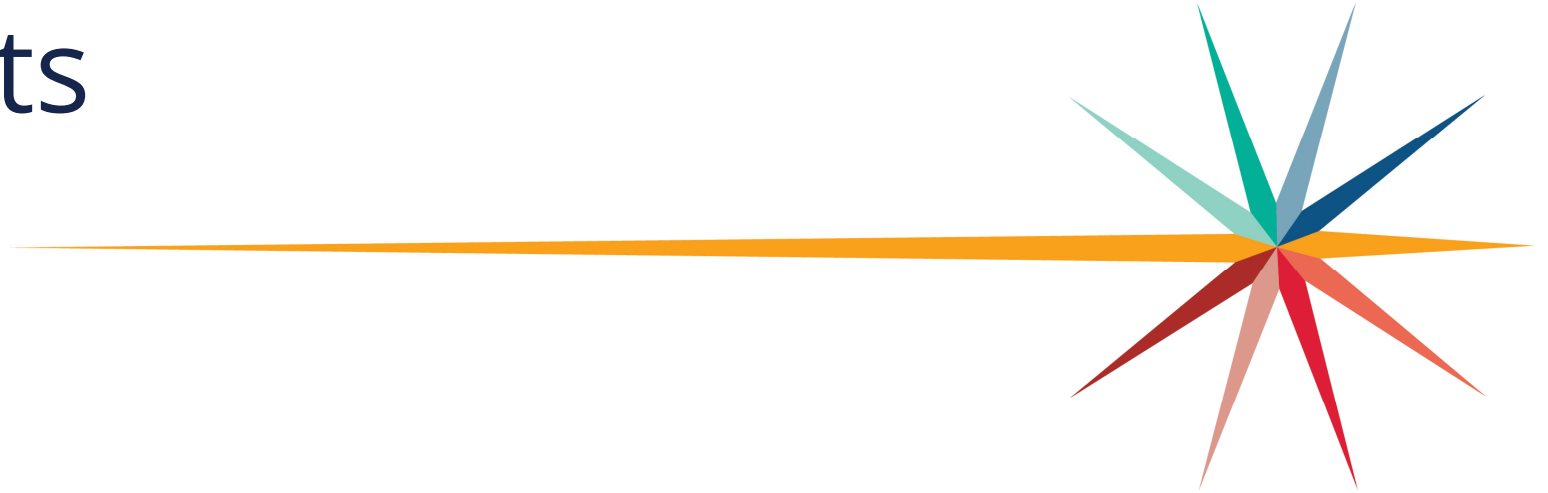
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- Submit in Validation before the window
- Review submission documentation & resources
- Run and review reports in KIDS to confirm proper submissions

- State History/Gov Assessment - Update grades tested to 09, 12, 15, 16, or 17

# What's New?

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**Removed:**

**ACT and ACT Workkeys will not be reported on TEST.**

# When



## **Window (August 8, 2022 – July 21, 2023)**

- August 8, 2022-November 28, 2022 (cPass)
- January – March (General Assessments & KELPA)

## **Need Not Test Date (March 20, 2023)**

- General Summative (Math, ELA, and Science)

# Who



## **Students – (Grade levels)**

- 08 – 17 (General Assessments)
- 05 – 17 (KELPA)
- January – March (General Assessments)

## **School**

- Accountability or Attendance – last record submitted

- State assessment test ticket
- Results to Accountability School
- AMOSS Population

# Assessments to Submit Now

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- Comprehensive Agriculture, Plant Systems, Animal Systems: Grade Level 14-17

# Assessments NOT in TEST



- Dynamic Learning Map (DLM):
  - Through KITE only
- Interim predictive assessments (TASC)
- ACT (Pearson)
- ACT Workkeys (Pearson)

# Assessments - General



- Career Tech Ed Pathways Assessments (cPass):
  - Grade Levels 14 - 17
- English Language Arts (ELA) and Math Assessments:
  - Grade Levels 8 - 13, and 15

# Assessments - General

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- History/Government Assessment:
  - Grades 09, 12, 15, 16, 17
- Science Assessment:
  - Grades 10, 13, and 16

# Best Practices - TEST

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- August 8, 2022 (cPass)
- January – March (General Assessments & KELPA)
- Submit all other TEST records in 2023

# Best Practices

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- Review submission documentation & resources
- Run and review reports in KIDS to confirm proper submissions



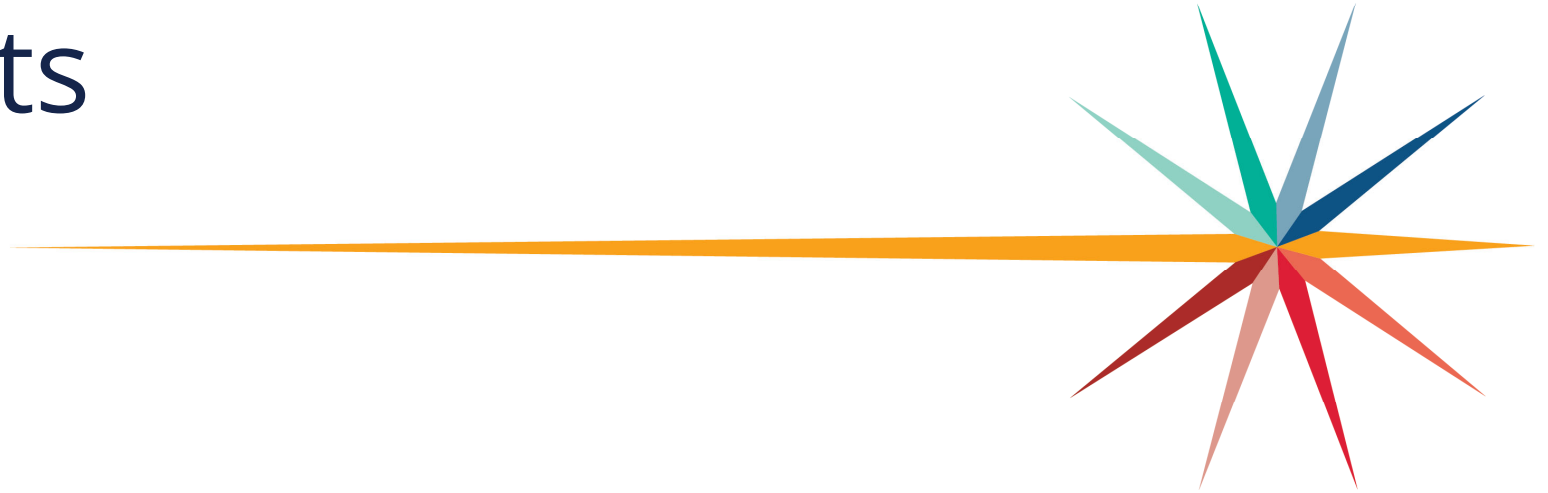
# KELPA Preparation

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- Submit before Jan 30
- New KELPA Proctors must be entered into EDCS before submissions.
- LPR does not have to be submitted—but the teachers must be entered

## 2022-2023 Kansas Assessment Program Overview

*All tests are delivered in Kite® Student Portal (except HGSS) and include multiple-choice and technology-enhanced items. KELPA speaking and writing assessments are human scored. All other assessments are machine-scored. Interim assessments are optional. General summative, Kansas English Language Proficiency Assessment (KELPA), History, Government, and Social Studies (HGSS), and Dynamic Learning Maps® (DLM®) assessments are mandatory.*
