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TASC Overview



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Purpose

- Link educators and students in KITE for interim assessments
 - ELA
 - Math

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Who Submits

- Attendance School (Student School Identifier)
- Includes Accredited Private Schools

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Submission Window

- September 6, 2022 – May 26, 2023

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Students to Submit

- Grade levels 8-13, & 15 for interim assessments
- Grade levels 7-17 for mini-test administration
- Public and Private school students

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TASC Details



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KITE

- Create rosters for Interim Assessments
- Creates teacher access to create mini-tests for ELA and Math
- Creates student access to mini-tests
- Allows teacher access to student mini-test performance
- Not State Assessments

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Undoing Records

- '99'
- Same School ID, SSID, School Year, State Subject Area Code, State Course ID, Educator ID

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Undoing Records

- '99' – Course Status field

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Current KITE Issues

- Students with special characters in their names will not populate KITE currently.

- Student Course: Current TASC Records
- Standard:
 - Accepted Records (Batch)
 - Accepted Records by Type-TASC



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General Best Practices



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Double Check Your Data

Look at your data before you submit:

- Check for 0's on ENRLs, EOYAs, and EXITs.
- Look at KCCID's on KCANs.
- Check for students no longer in your school.
- Look at TEST records—don't submit students who do not test (pre-K, K-2, etc)
- Look at TASC records—don't submit courses not English and Math.

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Use Validation Mode

- Check your uploads in KIDS
 - Before the windows open
 - During windows
 - Opportunities to correct data in SIS

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Pay Attention to...

- How you report homeschooled students.
- How you report private unaccredited students.
- How you report private school SPED students.
- How you report out of state students.

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Use KIDS Reports

- Reports are there to trouble shoot.
- Reports show what you have and have not submitted.
- Reports serve as reminders.
- Pay attention to the right reports at the right time.

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Use Batch History

- To retrieve State Student ID for ASGT records
- To review errors for correction
- Rerun batches (only 1 time)
- To create a new upload file for errored records
- Manage core data

Introduction - General
This document contains information specific to the submission of Teacher and Student Connection (TASC) records to the Kansas Individual Data on Students (KIDS) System data collection. The TASC data collection focuses on providing links among the course's students take during the school year and the educators teaching the courses.

A TASC Collection record is submitted only for those schools participating in Interim Assessments.
