When and Who

Window

- May 9, 2022 – June 30, 2022

Students

- GL 05-18 Any time “accountable” students

School

- Accountability or Attendance (0001/0002 Accountability)



Why

- Use of Data
 - Attendance rates and federal funding
 - Accountability subgroup determination
 - Title I data – used in LCP
 - Chronic absenteeism



EOYA Collection Details



AMOSS

- Academic Measures of Student Success
- Participation and Graduation rates, assessment performance
- Correction window when window opens



Attendance and Membership

- Days present and days school open
- Absent – per district
 - Not physically present
 - No instruction participation on/off site
 - Absences (excused) = no days attended



Changes in Status

- May reflect June 30 status
- Or last day of school
- Ex: 504 Qualified
- Appendix A



Chronic Absenteeism

- Days in Attendance / Days in Membership
- Federally mandated aggregated reports
- Students absent 10% or greater



Dyslexia Screener

- GLs – 05, 06, 07
- Identify dyslexic / struggling readers
- Use Screening Rubric link
- Requirements “reliable” and “valid”
- Optional



Dyslexia Spring Benchmark Performance Level:

- Performance level from Spring window



Dyslexia Subtest

- Dyslexia identifiers – PSF, NWF, ORF
- Kansas schools screening students
- KSDE values - K PSF (01), 1st NWF (02), 2nd ORF (03)
- Record Spring performance; not composite



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program

- Name change to Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Indication of eligibility based on Direct Certification
- Non CEP school do not change reporting
- CEP schools do NOT report 100%
- Household Economic Survey determination added



Federal Graduation Cohort Formula

- Grade Level 14 starts cohort
- Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate
 - Freshman +/- transfers in and out to Senior
 - Graduates/Adjusted cohort
- Formula follows over four years

- Qualifying conditions
- Qualifying collections
- (Appendix G File Specifications)

Grade Level '33'

- 3 years on/before August 31
- Meet at-risk criteria
- No IEP



History/Government Assessment

- GL : 09, 12, 16
- TEST - History/Gov Assessment "2"
- EOYA – mark three task scores – D77-D79
 - Participating schools/students– valid value
 - All other students/schools – "00"



History/Gov Scores

- Score Titles
 - Claim/Thesis
 - Evidence
 - Reasoning
- Score Values
 - 00 = Not assessed
 - 01 - 04 = Performance Level 1 - 4



Immigrant Student

- Age 3 – 21
- Not US born
- Not attending U.S. school for > 3 academic years
- Foreign Exchange Students



Inactive Students

- Submitting does not mean claiming



Individual Plan of Study

- Grade levels 11-17
- Blank for all other grades



Kansas Parents as Teachers Program (KPAT)

- Required for 00-04, & 33 GL, not 03
- Specific family program awareness
- Only students part of State-funded PAT programs
- Indicates current school year participation



Kansas Pre-K Pilot Program (KPP)

- Required for 01-04, & 33 GL, (not 03)
- Participates/ed in KPP during school year



Multiple Accountability Schools

- All schools “claiming” student
- John Smith
 - School A - 8/18/21 – 11/19/21
 - School B – 11/22/21 – 5/25/22



Qualified for 504

- Qualified – even without written plan
- W/D = qualified



Residence of Homeless Students While Homeless

- Nighttime residence
- Lacked fixed, regular, adequate residence
- At any time in school year



School Entry Date

- Date student entered Accountability School



Special Circumstances

- Accountability School '0001' or '0002'
 - Attendance School submit
 - Date taking classes at Attendance School



Title I Participation

- “School Wide” = ‘1’ – Including Pre-K if part of building
- “Targeted Assistance” – only students receiving



Truant Students

- “Yes”/ “No” field
- “Truancy” – state, district, or school policy violation
- State Statute – 72-2131 – authority and guidance



Undoing EOYA

- Cumulative Number of Days in Membership = -1
- Cumulative Number of Days Attended = 0



Virtual Education Students

- Virtual student at any point
- Only school/program or contractor submits



EOYA Collection Reports



Attendance

- Attendance Rate Report
- Average Daily Attendance
- Chronic Absenteeism
- Student Attendance Ratio Report



Data Quality

- Current Year EOYA Submission Comparison Report
- EOYA EXIT Assignment Comparison Report
- EOYA Prior Year Subgroup Comparison Report
- Virtual Schools Comparison Report



Standard

- Accepted Records by Type—EOYA
- Current Year Accountability Students
- EOYA Report
- Homeless Student

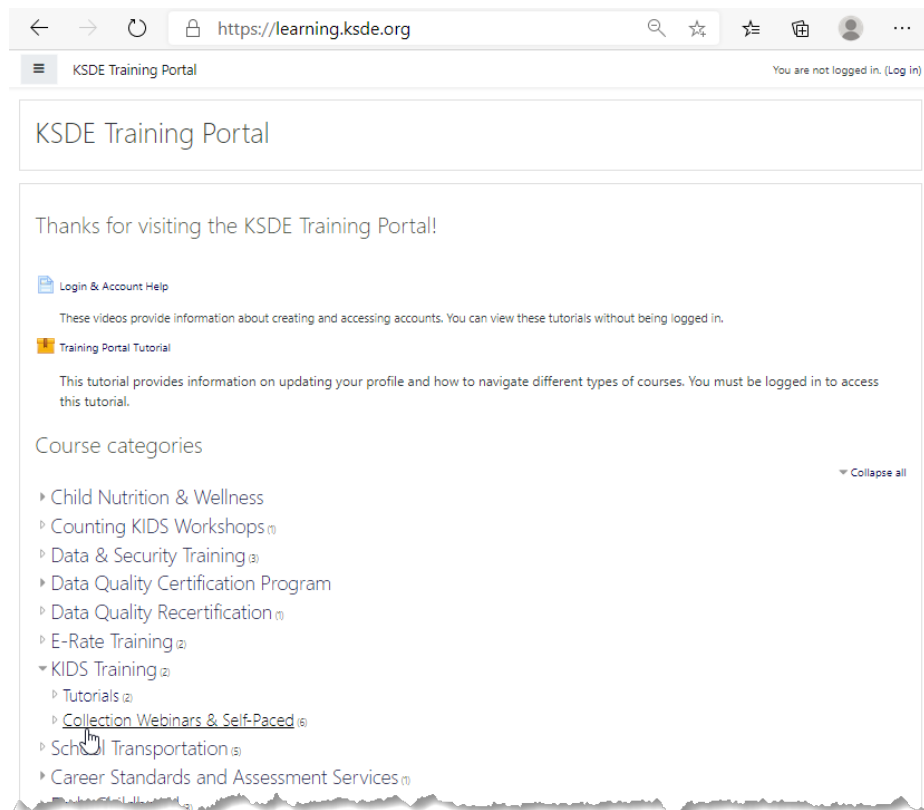

- Field Change: Eligibility for National School Lunch Program
 - Change
 - Add – values
 - Update – values



The Latest

- Remove: Kansas Qualified Admissions Pre-College Curriculum



Who Submits

- Accountability School
- Attendance School (if 0001 or 0002 Accountability)
- Accredited private schools



Submission Window

- Anytime KIDS open
- As soon as student leaves



Students to Submit

- Pre-K through adult
- Pre-K students
 - EXIT when student leaves Accountability School
 - Not when student leaves program

Data as of last day of membership



EXIT Details



Attendance and Membership

- Use total cumulative days
- John Smith (School “A” reports)
 - A – 08/12/21 – 11/23/21
 - B – 11/29/21 – 02/03/22
 - A – 02/04/22 – 05/15/22



Correcting an EXIT

- Incorrect Information
 - Resubmit: SSID, Acct Scl, Ex W/D Date, and correct info
- Incorrect Exit W/D Date
 - “99” and resubmit



Dropout/Graduation Summary Report

- 4-year adjusted cohort – annual dropout
 - 4-year adjusted cohort (n) - uses EOYA and EXIT

(Concentration Elective - DGSR)



Dropout/Graduation Summary Report

- 4-year adjusted cohort formula
 - X = four-year regular high school grads (seniors) (EXIT)
 - / divided by
 - Y = original freshman class (+ & - entry and exits) (EOYA)
 - N = 4-year adjusted cohort graduation rate

$$X / Y = N$$



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Change: ...and/or At-Risk Funding
- Add – values 3 & 4
- Update – values with respect to name change



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Free / Reduced-price lunch indication via
 - Direct Cert



Eligibility for National School Lunch Program and/or At-Risk Funding

- Approved CEP Schools
 - Not 100%
 - Only eligible via Household Economic Survey
- Non-CEP Schools – no change



EXIT and Assessments

- EXITs remove in KAP
- Undo – '99'
- Overall removal – not 'C' value



EXIT/Withdrawal Date

- Last day of membership, graduation, met graduation requirement
- When Accountability School affiliation ends
- School Year - May vs August



First Instructional Date

- Must complete if one or more of the following
 - Primary Disability = 'WD'
 - Gifted Student = 'GI'
 - Residence of Homeless... > 0
 - Military Connected ... > 0
- Blank if none of these conditions



First Instructional Date

Impact – Untimely EXITs

- As soon as possible
- Extended absence – schools, districts discretion
- TEST – assessed/not assessed
- Graduation – non-graduates, unresolved



School Entry / Special Circumstance

- School Entry Date
 - Accountability School
 - 0001 or 0002 – Attendance School
- Special Circumstances for Accountability School Submitting EXIT Records - 0001 or 0002 – Attendance School



Students With Disabilities

- Scenario One – Met grad requirements/no diploma
 - Use '22'
 - Did not receive diploma
 - W/D – Primary Disability
 - Post grad plans – D31
 - Continue receive transitional services
 - GL 17 – each year
 - '8' – When “Graduated”; (No longer receiving services)



Students With Disabilities

- Scenario Two – Suspended, Expelled
 - Still active, do not EXIT
 - District obligated
 - Legal requirements – SPED & Gen Ed
 - Administrators and counsel involved
 - Contact Mark Ward (mward@ksde.org)



Unweighted Grade Point Average

- Cumulative Graduating GPA
 - Required for value '8'
 - 0.00 – 4.00
 - 0.00 =F, 1.00=D, 2.00=C, 3.00=B, 4.00=A



EXIT Collection Reports



Data Quality Reports

- EOYA/EXIT Assignment Comparison Report



Standard

- Current Year
- Graduates
- Accountability Students
- Homeless Student
- Dropouts
- Unresolved Exits
- EXIT Status Report



End/Beginning of Year

- Graduation Comparison
- Unresolved EXITs (October)

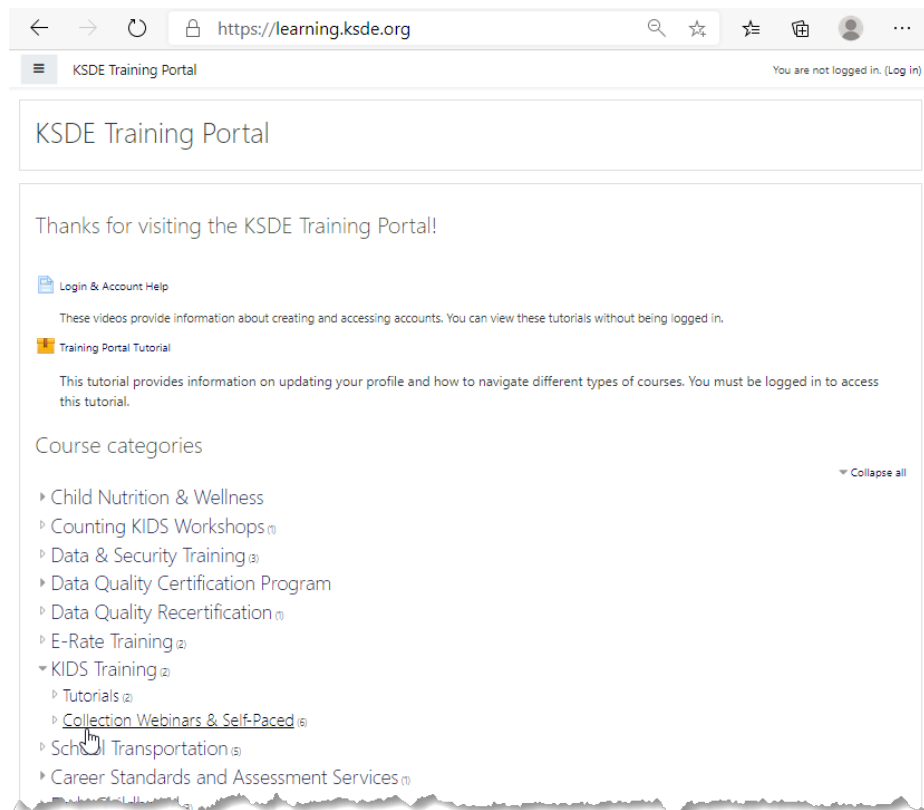
